



THE MONTICELLO MOTOR CLUB ON TRACK FOR SUMMER OPENING

MANAGEMENT TEAM FINALIZED AS WORK CONTINUES APACE ON NEW YORK'S NEW WORLD CLASS FACILITY

MONTICELLO, N.Y., February 6, 2008 - The Monticello Motor Club (MMC), North America's premiere motorsports country club, continues on schedule for its summer 2008 opening, according to President and CEO, William Mc Michael.

"This winter has been very kind to us," said Mc Michael. "We don't see anything standing between us and the realization of our vision."

The course, the combined design effort of MMC Legends Pro Brian Redman and Bruce Hawkins, features 4.1 miles of track spanning 600 acres of scenic Catskill Mountain lands. The design of this "master track" will allow for as many as 12 distinctly different configurations.

"The various permutations of the track will provide the members with the kind of challenges that will make every trip to MMC virtually unique," Mc Michael added.

Central to the MMC layout will be the 4.1 mile Grand Prix configuration, which includes grand corners, smooth high-speed sweeps, hairpin turns, tight corners and lengthy straights, all reminiscent of some of the classic racetracks around the world.

"We have put Brian Redman's unparalleled experience at place like Le Mans, Spa-Francorchamps, the Targa Florio and the Nurburgring to use and have incorporated what he has learned over the years to design a facility that will challenge, yet fulfill any driver's soul."

Redman, winner of 77 professional races in 12 countries and nine series championships during a 41-year professional career, will be regularly available at MMC to mentor the Club members.

In addition to moving closer to the completion of both the track and the physical facilities, MMC has announced several additions to their management team.

"We have added several key members to the MMC staff in order to ensure the highest quality, most enjoyable experience for our members," commented Mc Michael.

Additions to the MMC staff include Ari Straus, COO; and Jason Bannerman, Director of Sales and Marketing.

The Monticello Motor Club is the premiere road course country club in North America. In addition to the 4.1 miles of road course club also offers such amenities as a spectacular clubhouse, vehicle storage and maintenance facilities, and a skid pad. Located only 80 miles from New York City, the track is easily accessible from any of the New York Metropolitan area's five major airports. The track is scheduled to open in the summer of 2008. MMC members can tour, hot-lap and/or race, either in their own automobiles or choose from one of an array of available vintage, performance and race cars. Membership is limited to 500 resident, 250 non-resident and 10 race team members.
